2024/11/3. Confirmation of the minutes of 12th September 2024.

2024/11/4. Public Participation

Gill Davies asked for an update on Freds Field – details below.

2024/11/5. Actions and matters arising from those minutes

- a. Roads/speeding/laybys. Road cleaning, including Timbers Lane gullies arranged for 19 December 2024. Port Hill flooding continues to be a problem for residents and pavements in Nuffield village also need clearing. AY to contact team at OCC and copy FB for support.
- b. 20mph speed limit. Consultation period ends 15 Nov. All residents are encouraged to comment, particularly as there is mention of no change to the 40mph speed limit along the A4130. Link here: https://letstalk.oxfordshire.gov.uk/nuffield_20mph2024
- c. Fred's Field lease. A draft new contract has been received for a further 25 years. Registering as a Community Asset will be looked at again and FB to be copied in correspondence to support an application. Following discussions, GA will respond to the letter.
- d. Abandoned car Nuffield Lane. Car has now been moved.
- e. Hedging and fence at playground. FB suggested applying for a grant under the Councillor Priority Fund. AY to apply.
- f. Bus stop survey. Returned to OCC.

2024/11/9. Planning

- a. Pre-Planning Oakingham House, Whitcalls Lane, Nuffield. Tim Neil, Estate and Gardens Manager at Oakingham House outlined the owners' project to rewild the estate, inspired by Isabella Tree's book Wilding, collaborating with organisations such as Rewilding Britain. The intention being to return the fenced, grazed paddocks to nature and encourage biodiversity. The Parish Council have no objection to the project and ask that they are kept updated as there is a lot of interest from local residents.

New application is not subject to consultation.

Non material amendment to application ref. [P23/S3449/FUL](#) - reduction in total built-up area Erection of a two storey dwelling with 4 bedrooms and work rooms with an integrated garage. New application is not subject to consultation. **Target Decision Date 14th November 2024**

Erection of building and station of mobile butchery unit within that building, formation of new access with associated track, and associated works. **Target Decision Date 5th December 2024. No objections**

Demolish an existing garden shed and replace with a larger ancillary outbuilding for secure storage and workshop for garden machinery used to maintain the house and gardens.

Proposed erection of two 3-bedroom semi-detached dwelling houses. End consultation period 26th Sep 2024.

There was much discussion regarding this application and residents noted reasons for previous refusal included visibility at entrance onto A-road with national speed limit, no mains drainage and a disused septic tank on the land, over development in an AONB and market housing pricing. NPC will object and residents were advised to also contact Nettlebed PC, as this area is on the border of the two parishes. **No decision**
